Tournament Regulations

118 teams are divided into:

- 10 male groups (78 teams),
- 3 female groups (22 teams),
- 3 youth groups (18 teams).

The teams were divided into groups according to their time zones.

Time Control:

Game in 10 min + 5 sec per move starting from move 1

Team composition:

- The team consists of four (4) players with unlimited number of substitutes.





Format of the Championship



MALE - OPEN

Stage 1 7 or 8 teams – 10 groups. RR, 7 rounds.

(Groups) 2 best teams advance to FINAL GROUP

Stage 2 10 teams – 2 final groups. RR, 9 rounds.

(Final Groups) The best team advance to FINAL

Final Match KO duel of two matches + Tie Break



Notes:

- The tie-break system is in Annex 2. Article 2 TIE-BREAK RULES.
- Time Schedule for the Stage 2 and Final Match will be announced after the Stage 1 is over (it depends on the time zone of the teams in the finals)



Technical Requirements

Access to the Internet: can be wired or Wi-Fi



Number of computers:

- 4 computers for prisoners to use for matches.
- 1 computer for staff communication.



Number of cameras:

- It is every teams' responsibility to have at least one web camera covering the playing zone or arbiter should be present in the playing room. (NO cameras required at the playing site).
- the cameras should not cover the faces of the players.

CHESS FOR FREEDOM



Requirements for the computer software



- A computer that runs a Windows operating system is recommended.
- There will be NO software that will be required to install.
- www.chess.com will be a platform for the event.
- Each team will receive 5 accounts. 4 of them shall be used by players. One – for staff observations. ALL accounts will have security check and ALL communications besides playing the games will be turned off.





Communication



- All communication with the teams shall be done through one designated person located at the local correctional facility.
- No direct communication with players.



Internet disconnection:

- During a game, if player disconnects from the playing zone, the game clock shall continue running.
- If the player can reconnect to the game before remaining time elapsed, the game can be continued.
- If the player cannot reconnect to the game before the time is elapsed, then the player shall lose the game. (However, the game is drawn if the position is such that the opponent can not checkmate the player's King by any possible legal moves.)







Fair Play Measures





Fair Play - Summary

Fair play decisions will be taken by the FIDE Fair Play Panel. They will consider the following inputs:

- Chess.com Fair Play data
- FIDE Screening Tool data provided by Prof. Regan
- Visual evidence from the arbiters on the Zoom call FOR FREEDOM



Options available to the FPP include:


- Overturning results
- Disqualifying a team from the tournament

Captain or Local Supervisor:

Captains and Supervisors should take responsibility for ensuring that their players play their games without external assistance



Appeals procedure





- All appeals and protests shall be submitted by the team representatives in writing to the Appeal Committee **no later than 15 minutes** after the completion of the relevant game or after the alleged infringement occurred.
- The Appeals Committee shall endeavor to make a decision as quickly as possible.




General Information

Each team will receive 5 accounts. For example:

- male: **Serbia_A**, or B, C, D, E
- female: **Serbia_WA**, or B, C, D, E
- youth: **Serbia_YA**, or B, C, D, E

The second team will receive the following accounts: Serbia_AA, or BB, CC, DD, EE






Before the start of the games

Initial procedure for Players:

- 1) Log in at chess.com
- 2) Wait at chess.com/play/online





Be sure that you did not disconnect from it – this can happen if you've been connected for a long time and done nothing.

- 2) Change the Display Name on the Zoom


